



FIRM WINS REVERSAL IN ALABAMA SUPREME COURT

BIRMINGHAM, AL – The firm is now readying for trial in a medical malpractice case that has left a young child blinded for the rest of her life.

This case was originally filed against multiple defendants for their combined and concurring negligence that resulted in the injuries suffered by this brave child. Some of the defendants have settled while others have challenged the law that allows a plaintiff to seek a recovery from all of the defendants who contributed to cause her harm.
